Dear Fellow Pemi Club Member,

The Club has exciting news for the 2019 membership year. The Board of Directors has approved the restructuring of Membership Dues that will be effective January 1, 2019. We will no longer be charging daily or annual range fees. For safety and security reasons, signing in and out of the Club ranges will still be required.

The new Membership Dues are as follows;

- Single Membership - \$100 per year.
- Family Membership - \$150 per year.
- Single Membership (age 68-79) - \$50 per year, with a two-year waiting period for new members.
- Family Membership (ages 68-79) - \$100.00 per year, with a two-year waiting period for new members.
- Single Membership (age 80+) - \$0 per year.
- New member & late renewal fee - \$20.
- Indoor Range Membership - \$30 per year.
- One-day (Guest) Membership - \$10 per day.

This is a revenue-neutral change in the dues structure, designed to eliminate most of the paperwork necessary to access the Club's ranges, along with the need for members to have correct change for the daily range fee.

The Board is also aware of concerns voiced by many members about range access on weekends. The number of scheduled special events requiring range closures has unduly impacted use of the club ranges by the general membership, particularly the 200-yd rifle range. To correct the problem, the Board has implemented a new scheduling priority system that will reduce the number of range closures for scheduled events. For next season, there will be two open weekends on the ranges each month to insure access to the ranges for members.

These changes in Club operations are part of our ongoing efforts to improve the quality of the membership experience at the Club. As always, your comments and suggestions are welcome.
