

OLYMPIC FINAL

The top eight shooters on the day at Budleigh Farm are invited to fire another 10 shots in the form of an old style Olympic Final. This competition is sponsored by Dave Reed, Marilyn Avery and “Banana Frog Cars”

This year, because of other commitments, some of the top 8 left early so those who accepted the invitation were 8 from the top 14!

All shooters were allowed a short period of ‘sighting-in’ time then given just 30 seconds to fire a single shot. A ‘scoped’ score for each shooter was announced after each shot and they were then allowed another 30 seconds for the next shot. Shots 1 to 5 were to be fired at the top left-hand diagram and then shots 6 to 10 at the top right hand diagram.

All ‘scoped’ scores were verified after everyone had fired their ten shots.

There was an apparent tie, but one of the shooters disqualified himself, explaining he had fired twice in 30 seconds on the 6th shot. He had inadvertently aimed at the sighting diagram so put another shot down, on the correct diagram. He then disqualified himself!
