

April 27th 2008 Match

Here are the results from yesterday's match. I re-scored everyone's target with an eye towards consistent calls on those close shots: some folks were hard on themselves (Jim, say) and some folks were, uh, somewhat generous to themselves (I'll just leave it at that). Actually, there were only a few places where I changed the score. Oh, and I fixed an arithmetic mistake or two.

I measured the target we used because I was curious how it compares to the 600-yard target (the one reduced to 100 yards). Here's how the rings compare:

MR-51 A-50 (the one we used yesterday)

X-ring: 1" 9-ring: 1"

10-ring: 2" 8-ring: 1 3/4"

7-ring: 2 1/4"

So all 8s yesterday would have been 10s on the standard 600-yard target. So we had ourselves a real challenging target yesterday!

So with that, the scores:

Jim Nelson 175-0x 173-2x 348-2x

Dana Fogarty 175-6x 170-1x 345-7x

Randy Enger 163-1x 162-1x 325-2x

Asi Lang 159-0x 160-1x 319-1x

Rick Dearborn 147-2x 170-1x 317-3x

Dave Casper 124-1x 163-1x 287-2x

Good shooting, Jim!

Just for fun, I calculated what Jim and Dana's scores would have been on the standard 600-yard target. (There's some judgment -- that is, guessing -- in all this, of course.)

Jim Nelson 199-14x 200-10x 399-24x

Dana Fogarty 199-12x 198-12x 397-24x

That's darn good shooting!

But, just so Jim and Dana don't get too confident for the next time we do this, note that:

I cross-fired a 10 onto Asi's target in the first string, and had a scope problem at the end of the second string.

Asi lost count of the rounds in the first string and shot only 19.

Dick and Dave both figured something out by the second string: look at the big jumps from string 1 to string 2!
